



## Aviation industry professionals flock to EASA's Third Industry Meeting in Cologne

*The third industry meeting of the European Aviation Safety Agency experienced unprecedented levels of attendance from representatives of the European aviation industry. Over 200 experts attended the all-day event, which was the first to be held at the Agency's new headquarters in Cologne.*

Industry meetings are part of a transparency initiative from the fledgling European Agency to communicate its activities to stakeholders and to cement its links with industry. Attendance covered the full scope of industry ranging from small general aviation manufacturers to large aircraft manufacturers and operators.

Issues such as the Agency's fees and charges policy and the new regulation on operations and licensing were debated. Written questions and concerns addressed to the Agency before the event were widely discussed during a questions and answers session. This interactive session contributed to clarify issues linked to the implementation and interpretation of rulemaking procedures.

Given the encouraging attendance and interest of the industry representatives, the Agency reiterated its intention to organise similar events in the future.
