

Getting to Horion Haus

EASA's Headquarters are located in Köln-Deutz, Ottoplatz 1, close to East Bank of the river Rhine, opposite Köln-Deutz railway station and behind the Hyatt International Hotel.

The "Rhein/Ruhr/Erft" meeting room (Horion Haus) is located at the end of EASA's office building.

From Köln-Bonn Airport (CGN)

By train Take train nr. 13 towards "Köln-Hauptbahnhof" (Central Station). Get off at "Köln-Deutz", about 13 minutes after leaving the airport. On leaving the station, turn right and head towards the tall tower (see picture, right), which is located across the Ottoplatz from the station. This is the EASA's office building. There is a train from the airport every 20-30 minutes. The price of a one-way ticket is 2 euros (single).

By taxi The trip takes about 30 minutes and costs approx. 30 euros.

From Frankfurt Airport

By train Take the ICE (Intercity Express) or IC (Intercity) train to "Köln-Hauptbahnhof". There is an ICE train from the airport every 30 minutes. The price of a single ticket is 50 euros and the journey takes approximately 1 hour. There is also an IC train every 2 hours from the airport. The price of a single is 34 euros and the journey takes 2 hours.

From Köln-Hauptbahnhof (Cologne Central Station)

By foot from the main station Follow the signs to "Köln-Messe" as soon as you come out of the station, then walk across the iron bridge, the "Hohenzollernbrücke" to cross the river Rhine (around 20 minutes). EASA's entrance is on the other side of the block from the Hyatt hotel.

By train Take a train which stops at Köln-Deutz.

From the center of Cologne (Heumarkt or Neumarkt)

Take the tram (Strassenbahn), Line 1, towards "Bergisch-Gladbach-Bensberg", Line 7, towards "Köln-Porz-Zündorf", or Line 9, towards "Königsforst." Get off at "Deutzer Freiheit". A one-way ticket costs 1.20 euros.

By car

From Brussels Take the E40 to Liège, Aachen, Cologne. Follow directions to Köln-Zentrum / Köln-Deutz / Köln Arena / Kölnmesse. Take the second exit after crossing the river - Kreuz Gremberg, towards **Köln-Deutz/Centrum**. Stay in the lane indicating "Köln-Deutz", and you will end up in front of the tower and the EASA office building.

From any other starting point Follow **Koelnmesse**, then Köln-Deutz.

Parking You can park in the underground carpark alongside the Agency building which is open from 6am to 10pm at 1 euro per hour. You may also park in the street to the left of the offices at 3 euros per 24 hours.
