



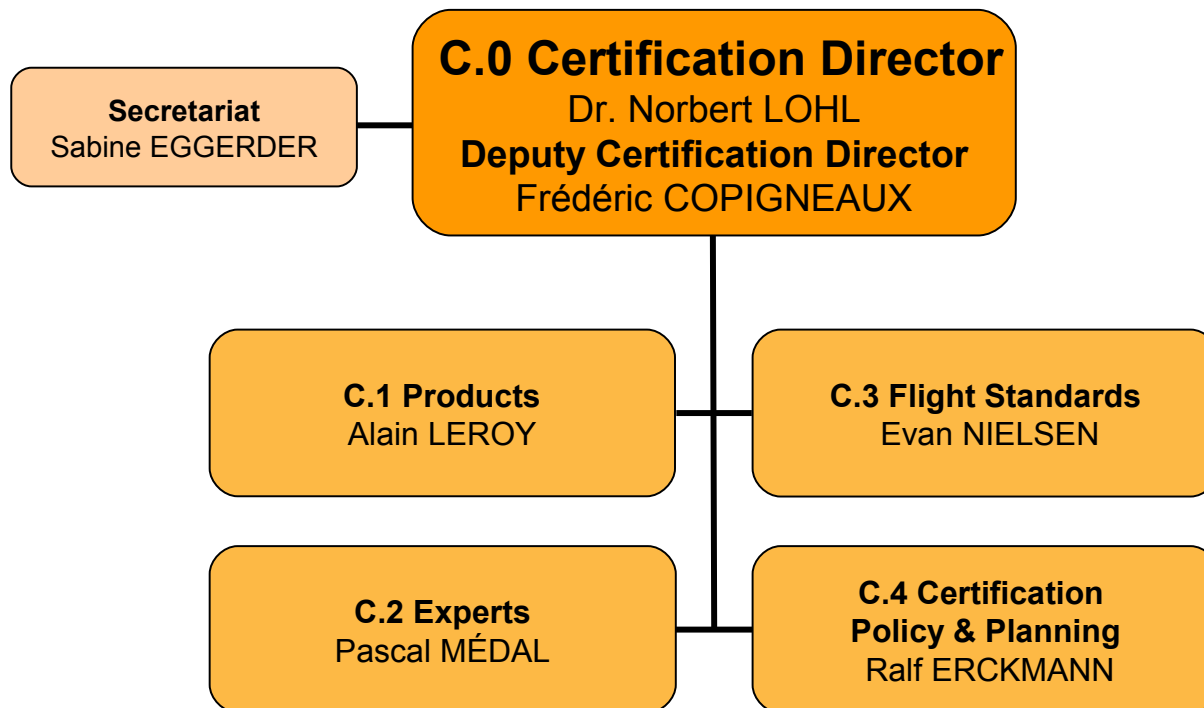

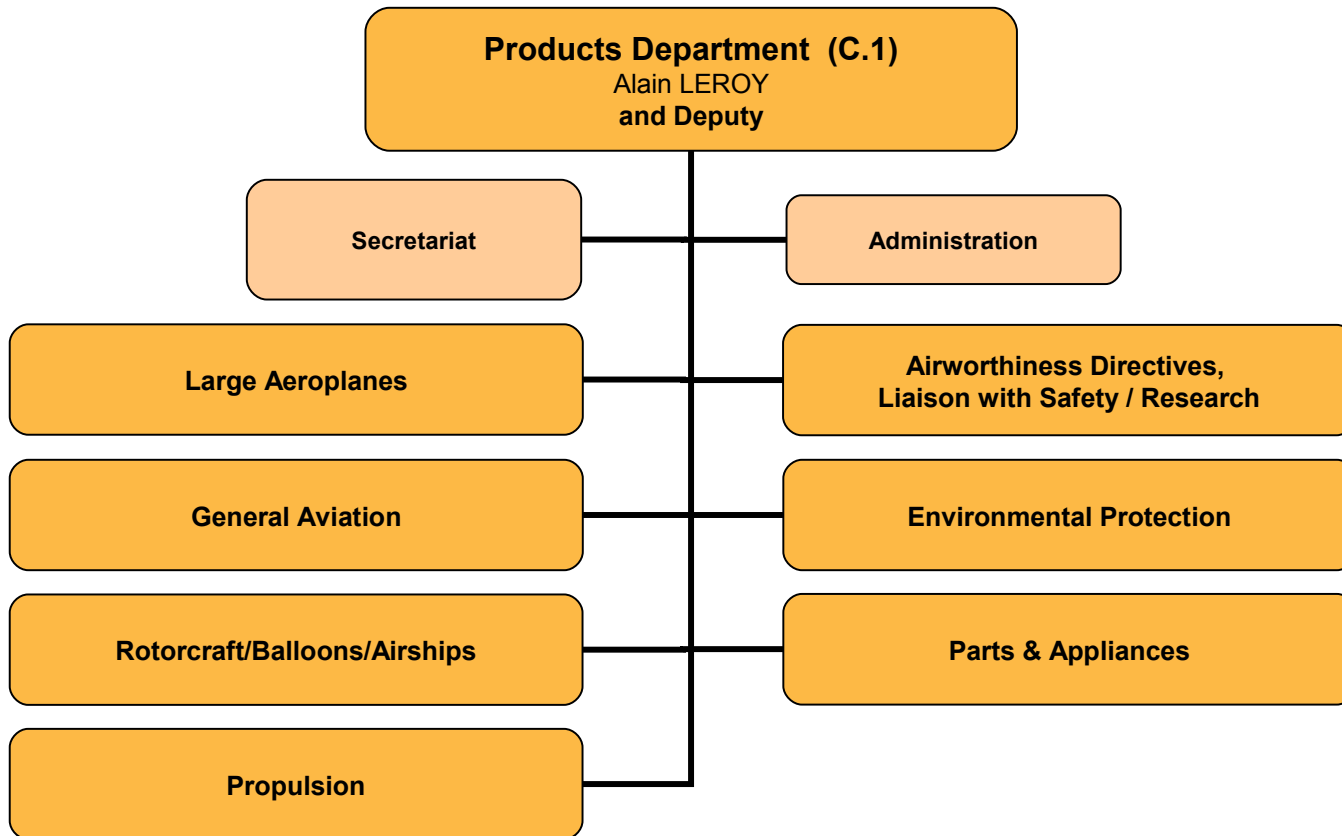

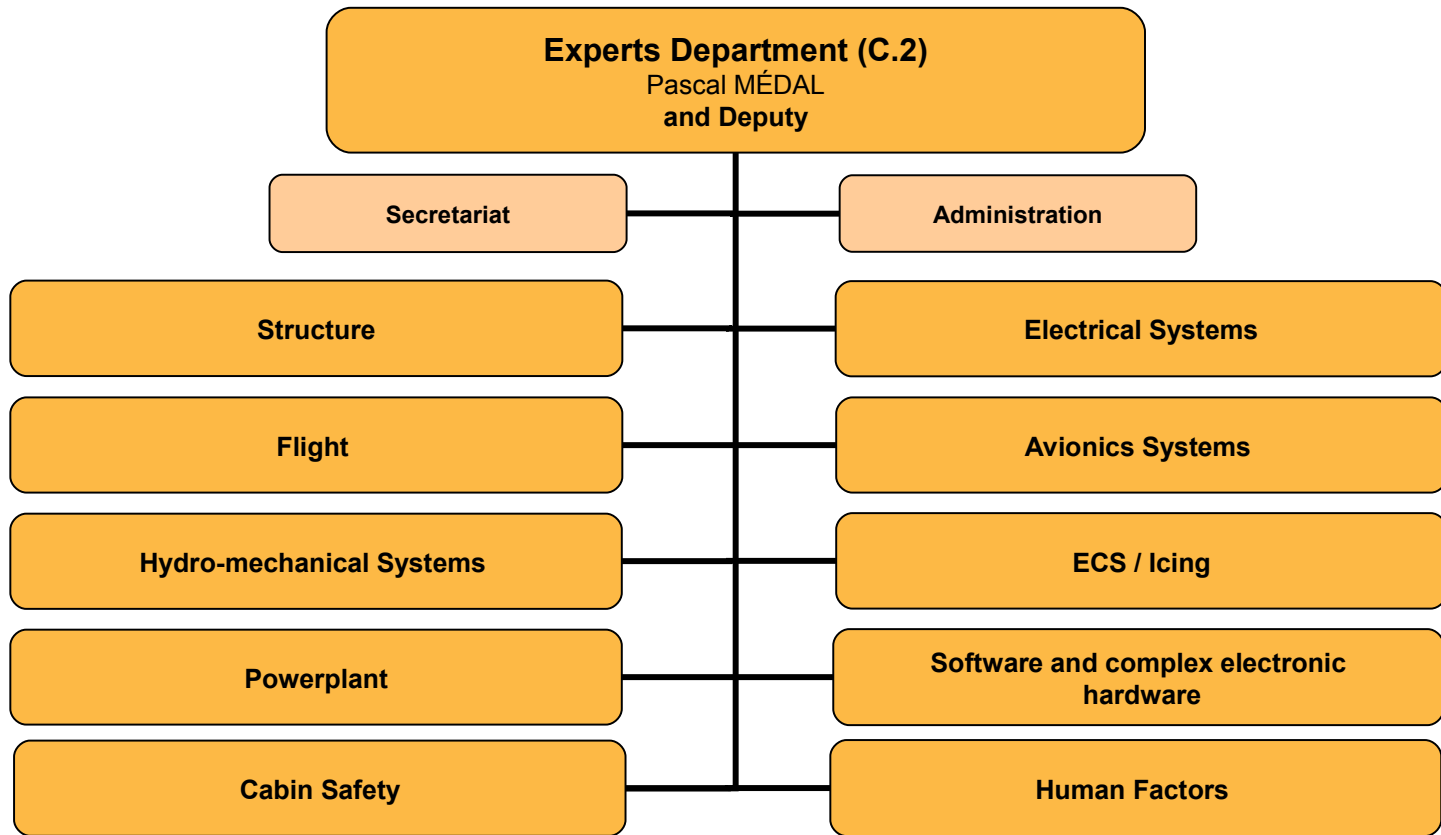

Current activities of the Directorate

- **Airworthiness and Environmental Certification**
TC, STC, ETSO-A, changes/repairs, validation support, etc.
- **Continuing Airworthiness activities**
Airworthiness Directives, etc.
- **DOA Activities**
Providing technical expertise for DOA surveillance
- **Flight Standards activities**
MRB Process, coordination of other Flight Standards activities for JAA
- **Certification related activities**
Support activities, e.g. pre-application consultancy



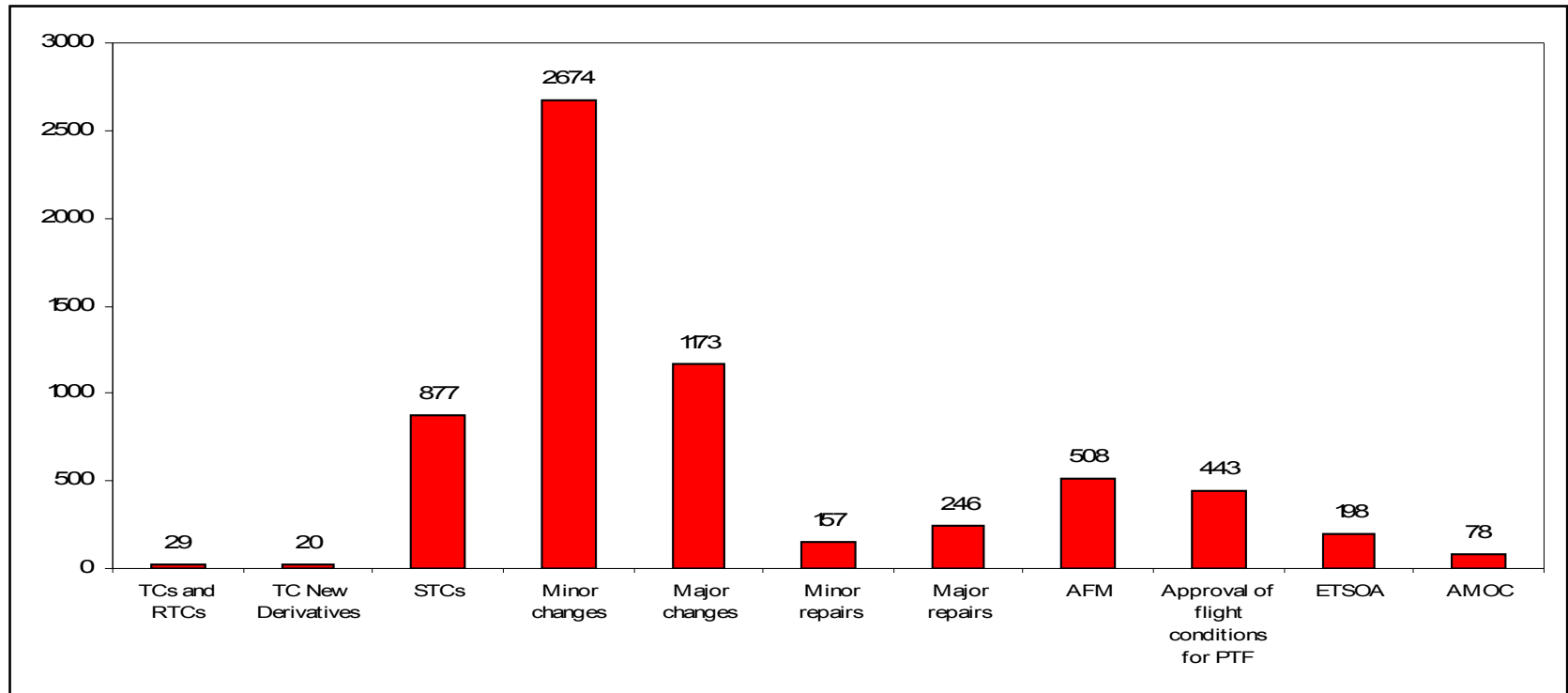
New tasks under amended EASA Basic Regulation 216/2008

The Certification Directorate receives new competences in the field of Flight Standards activities:

- **Coordination of the OEB process**
e.g. minimum syllabus of pilot type rating, master minimum equipment list (MMEL), etc.
- **Certification of foreign Flight Simulation Training Devices (FSTD)**



Product Certification (2007)

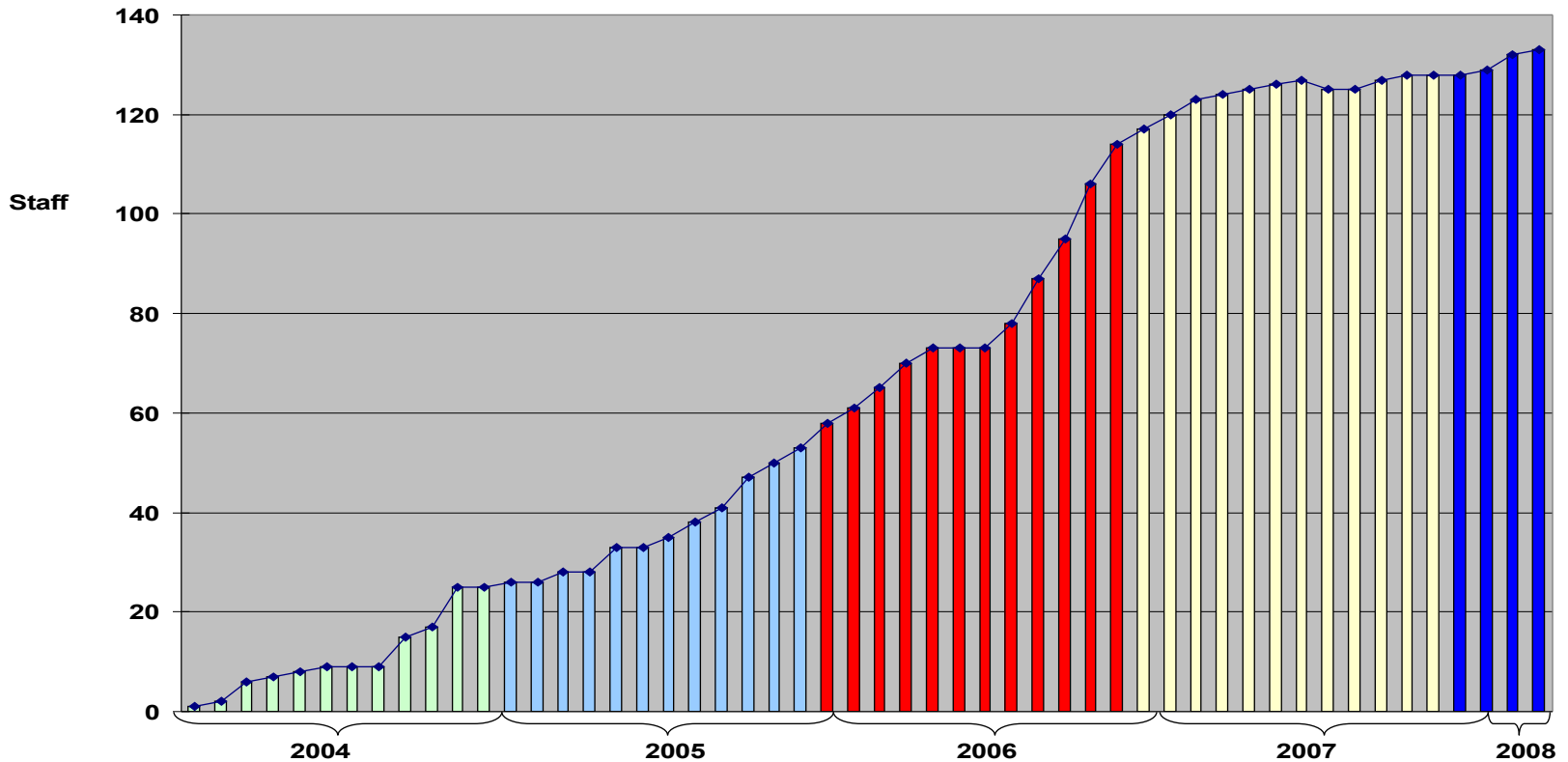


Total number of certificates issued in 2007: 6403

Activity outsourcing

- The Directorate's level of activity outsourcing has been reduced in relation to the staff development.
- In 2008, 60% of the activities are performed by EASA, 40% outsourced to NAAs.
- The Directorate aims at achieving an outsourcing level of only 20% by 2011.
