The European Community Regulatory System

Legislative Role  **Commission, assisted by EASA**

Executive Role  **NAA, assisted by EASA** 

Monitoring Role  **Commission, assisted by EASA**

 **or directly EASA**, *when the legislator decides this is more convenient (principle of subsidiarity)*

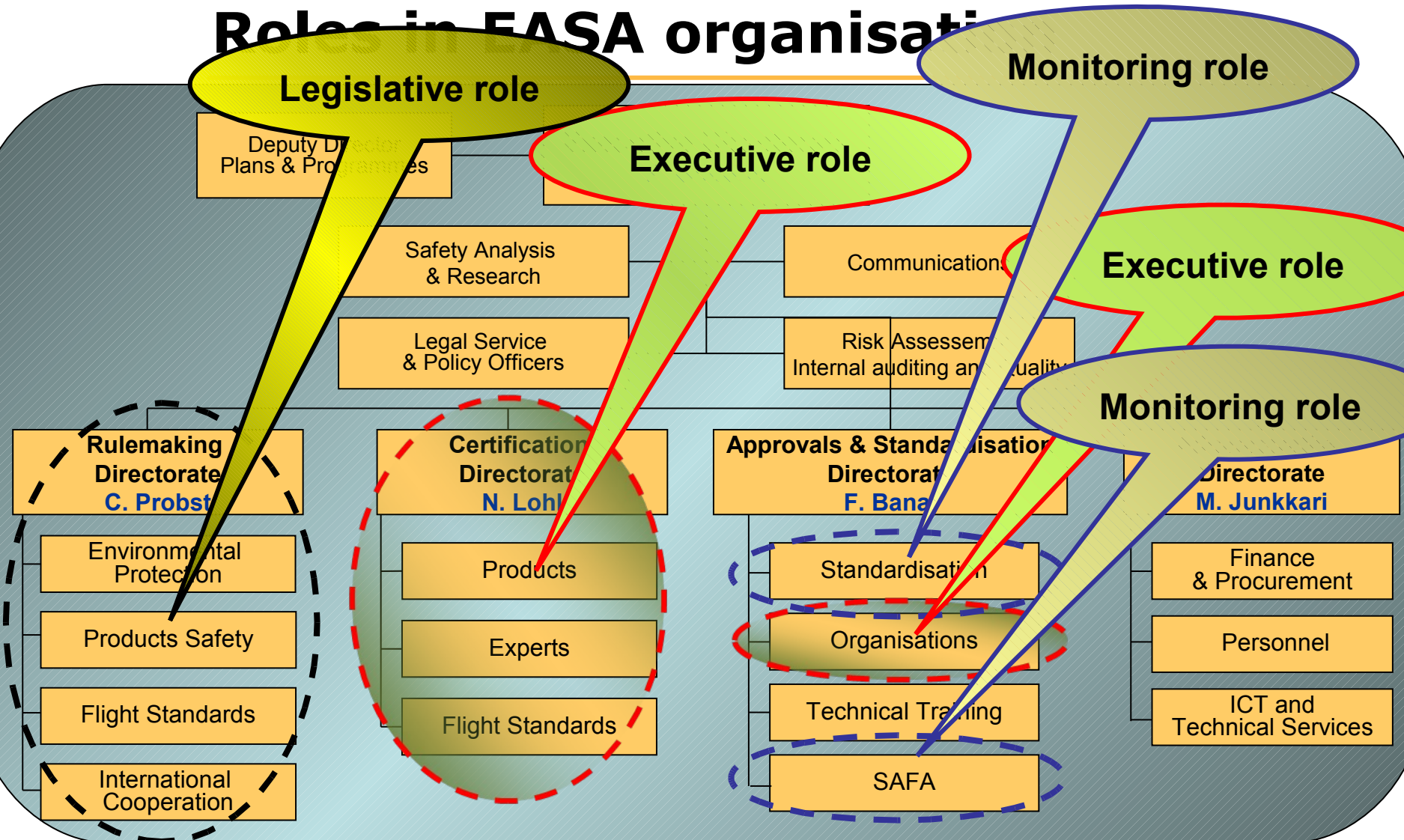

- Maintenance Organisations (third countries)
- Maintenance Training Organisations (third countries)
- Cont. Airw. Management Organisations (third countries)



Technical Training Department

→ Tasks

- To define Training Programmes for EASA Technical Staff and NAA Standardisation inspectors
- To provide EASA Technical Staff and NAA Standardisation inspectors with Training in accordance with the defined Training Programmes
- To promote worldwide high quality training standards on EU aviation regulations and EASA measures/procedures
- To manage the Technical Library of the Agency



SAFA Coordination Department

→ Tasks

- Development and management of the centralised SAFA Database
- Short-Medium Term SAFA Data Analysis
- Alerting function to Commission and NAA
- Developing and fostering the implementation of training courses for NAA inspectors
- Developing and proposing SAFA procedures
- Preparing SAFA annual report
