
It is my pleasure to invite you to a one-day introductory Workshop on the European Aviation Safety Agency's (EASA) extension of responsibility. The workshop aims to inform aviation experts about the new Basic Regulation which will extend the Agency's responsibilities to rulemaking activities in the field of Flight Crew Licensing and Operations as well as to oversight of Third Country Operators. Due to the expected high interest in this topic, the Agency decided to offer two workshops with the same programme on 28 and on 29 April 2008 in Cologne.

These first general sessions will focus on the Regulatory System, the Agency's Rulemaking Procedures, the Rulemaking Drafting Groups, and will give an overview of the different Notices of Proposed Amendment which will be published in the forthcoming months. It is our intention to acquaint the participants in detail with the Agency's rulemaking process in order for you to use your possibilities of taking influence.
